Because of his love and strong desire to drive trucks; he attended All State Career Commercial Driving School where he obtained his Class A license. Gregory started his truck driving career with Time Critical Freight and as he grew in his career he continued to add several state endorsements, hazmat, Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) to his CDL license. While working for 3 D trucking, on Mother’s Day 2004 he met the love of his life, Crystal Jefferson. They were married in 2012. From this union, the couple was blessed with three children, and together they formed a blended family of six children (Jaelon, Jordyn, Jeremiah, Jacob, Jaylin and Justyn). Gregory was a devoted husband and family man. He truly loved and adored his family.

A time to love: Our precious Doobie was passionate about all aspects of music. His love for music as a disc jockey (DJ) began in the basement where he would mix and scratch with two turn tables. He played music at his friends and neighbors parties. He went from playing music in the basement to creating beats and writing songs in the studio. Doobie was a model to young fathers, guiding them to understand the importance of being a father to their children.
